

## Meeting the Public Sector Apprenticeship Target - Reporting

In line with statutory guidance the Holy Family Catholic Multi Academy (HFCMAT) Trust falls under the scope of the Public Sector Apprenticeship Target.

As such the HFCMAT has a target to employ an average of 2.3% of new staff as apprentices over the period I April 2017 to 31 March 21.

The information below indicates its performance and progress against this target.

## Factors that impacted on the ability to meet the target

The HFCMAT has historically employed apprentices via an agent. Due to the nature of the reporting these are excluded from the figures. The plan is to move apprentices to direct employment.

COVID-19 has significantly been a challenge. Schools has had periods of closure with staff working from home. This did not provide an environment that was conducive with taking on new apprentices.

## How we are planning to meet the target in the future

As and when recruitment is taking place roles will be reviewed to see if an apprentice is an option.

In addition, apprentices will be appointed directly so they appear in the statistics.
